

Completion of the Coldry Process Production trial

ECT has successfully completed the production run of its Coldry Process plant in Bacchus Marsh, Victoria.

Managing Director Con Galtos said the 60-day 24/5 production trial had been successfully completed.

“The plant operated 24 hours per day five days a week and our goal to run a plant on a commercial basis has been achieved. We know that we can produce one tonne of Coldry pellets and one tonne of water for every two tonnes of brown coal. Samples of the water have been sent for chemical analysis and the results will be announced in due course,” Mr Galtos said.

ECT, in association with Mecrus, has now commenced the scaling up process and the company has launched its Go to Market strategy.

“This is a significant moment in the company's history,” Mr Galtos said.

“We've moved out of the development stage and now are ready to go to market.”

Mr Galtos also expressed his appreciation to Mecrus who were the project's managers for the upgrading of the plant, the production run and is now preparing the scaling up process. In doing so, ECT will continue to liaise with national and international engineering companies capable of offering turn key operation to potential clients.
